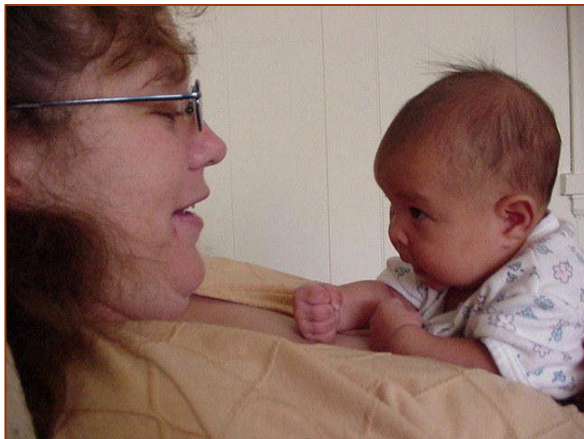

Who is Eligible?

1. Expectant mothers or families who have a child between ages 0-3.
2. Families who meet income guidelines.
3. Families who have a child with a special need.
