Once a week visit from a trained educator plus two socializations a month.

### Center Base -Half Day

Four hours / five days a week preschool experience plus teacher home visits and a parent teacher conference per semester.

### Full Day / Full Year

Six hours / five days a week preschool experience, plus teacher home visits and a parent teacher conference per semester.

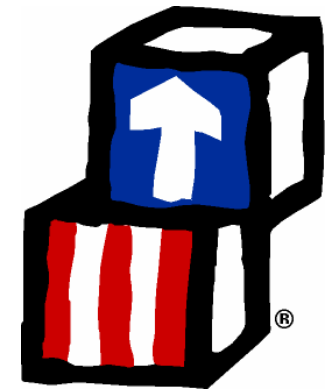
