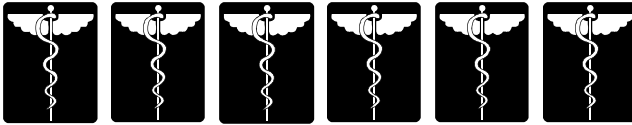

Migrant Health Center provides basic health care for migrant and / or seasonal farm workers for eleven panhandle counties:

Primary/Migrant Health Clinic

Provides a full range of basic medical services for all age groups, prenatal care, x-ray, laboratory, pediatric care, geriatric care, wellness and health education.

Migrant Health collaborates with the following Community Action Partnership of Western Nebraska Health Center departments:

Dental Clinic provides services for children and adults, focusing on dental prevention and education for our clients and community. Clients are provided with dental exams, x-rays, cleanings, sealants, crowns, bridges and other services.

Diabetes Specialty Clinic provides education and support to help diabetics avoid complications. Monthly support group scheduled.

Ryan White Specialty Clinic– Hepatitis C Specialty Clinic provides Confidential and Anonymous testing, education and counseling by trained HIV/HCV Counselors.

Immunization Services provides free immunizations for children ages two months through age eighteen. Vaccinations available for adults.

Minority Health Initiative provides wellness education, health screenings referrals and interpretation and /or transportation to medical appointments.

Lead Screening provides free lead screening for children age six and under.

Nebraska's "Every Woman Matters" Program provides breast exams, pelvic exams and referrals, if indicated for mammograms.

Reproductive Health Care Program

Provides reproductive health care services for men and women emphasizing education and preventive health care.

Women, Infants, and Children

(WIC) Nutrition education and supplemental foods to Women, Infants and Children.

Your family may be served by one or more of the programs. Health Center staff is available to answer questions Concerning the Health Center. Staff provide quality health care to clients, treating everyone with respect and addressing their needs as quickly as possible. Clients are seen as close to their appointment time as possible. Walk-ins welcome.
